Recognizing the financial struggles of single parents, particularly mothers, we offer free hairdressing training to those in need. This program provides them with:

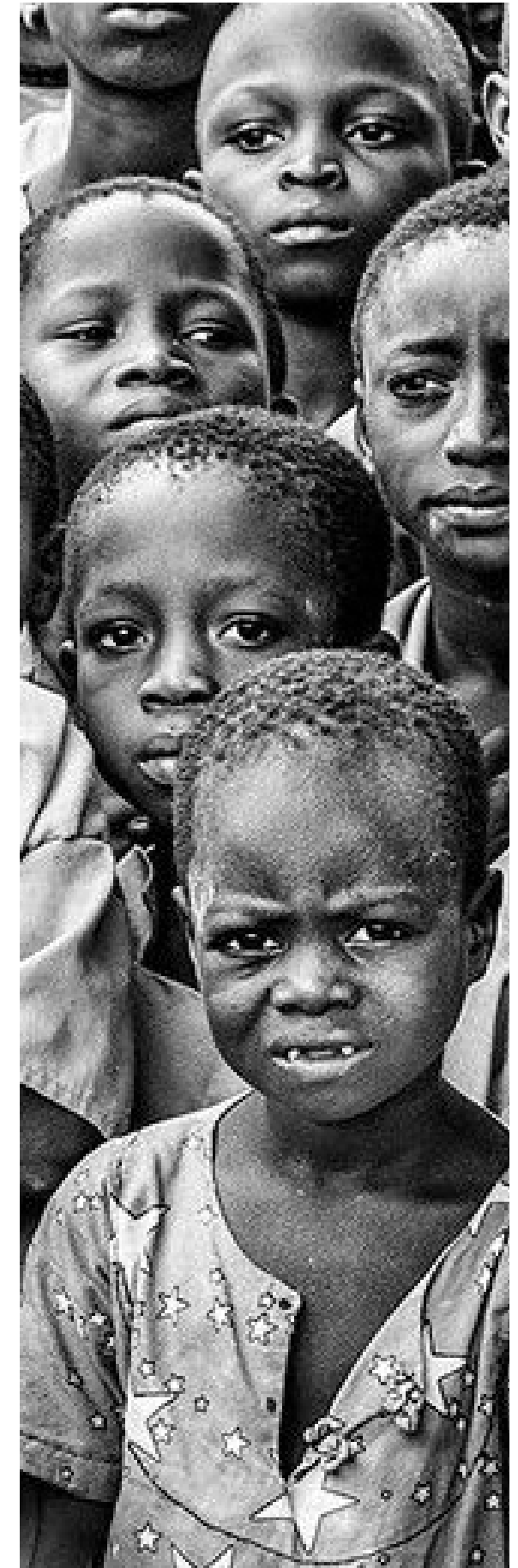
- ◆ A valuable skill that can lead to employment or self-employment.

# SONG ANALYSIS: “MUMMY” AND ITS CONNECTION TO MY BASIC NEEDS CHARITY FOUNDATION (MBNF)

The song “Mummy” is a heartfelt expression of the struggles faced by underprivileged children, highlighting the pain of poverty, hunger, and the difficult choices they are forced to make. The lyrics paint a vivid picture of a child who desperately wants to focus on education but is held back by basic survival challenges—hunger, exhaustion, and the need to work to support themselves.



## Verse 1: The Impact of Hunger on Education

The opening verse captures a child sitting in a classroom, unable to concentrate because of hunger. The teacher is teaching numbers, but the child’s mind is preoccupied with basic survival—even something as simple as learning the alphabet feels out of reach. The line “I’m going to Bolgatanga, I wasn’t born to be stupid” reflects the child’s inner frustration—they know they are capable, but their circumstances make success feel unattainable. This directly connects to MBNF’s mission of providing nutritious meals, ensuring that children are not forced to learn on an empty stomach.

## Verse 2: The Struggles of Child Labor and Poverty

The second verse shifts to another harsh reality—children being forced to work instead of focusing on school. The child’s feet are aching from hard labor, a tragic reality for many children in deprived communities. Despite wanting an education, they have no choice but to work to support their basic needs. MBNF’s clothing support and community collaboration initiatives aim to alleviate such struggles, ensuring that children have the resources to stay in school instead of being burdened by survival responsibilities.

## Chorus: A Cry for Help

The repeated call of “Mummy, Mummy” in the chorus is a plea for rescue—a child calling out for help, guidance, and support. This resonates deeply with MBNF’s goal of restoring dignity and hope to children facing hardship. The foundation acts as a support system, stepping in where families may struggle, ensuring that children do not feel alone in their fight against poverty.

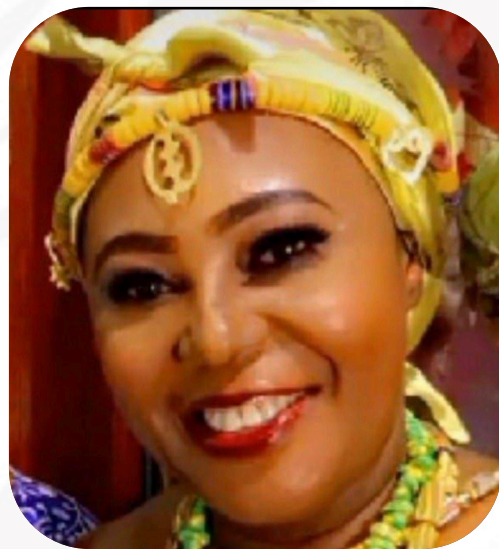
